Progress since December 2008		

Fareham work streams within Health & Well Being (SE Public Health Liaison Board) Action Plan is up to date to December 2008. Progress since December 2008 will be showing in the plan at March 2009.

At the last, Officers meeting (27th January) it was agreed that all work streams in the plan would be assessed up to the end of March 2009 and colour-rated regarding their annual achievement against their outset Performance Monitoring Measure. It was agreed that this self assessment process would enable a 2009/10 refresh of the plan and some target setting to drive further progress over 2009-10.

Key headlines since December 2008:

- A working group has been established with representation from the Hampshire Healthy Schools Team, Hampshire PCT and FBC to identify and deliver work aimed at prevention and reduction in levels of adult and childhood obesity
- FBC Community Development are supporting partnership work with Hampshire PCT on an older person's fall prevention initiative for delivery over 2009
- A report has been submitted to the Community Policy Development and Review Panel (14th January) with a proposal on a revised scheme via the In-Touch Housing Improvement Agency to fulfil the current Home Check remit and support an overall budget reduction
- A Public Health Workforce Development proposal has been circulated to engage Members and officers in training aimed at developing and strengthening cross-cutting public health and well being knowledge and capacities within local authorities. This will be delivered before end June 2009.
