Progress since December 2008			
<p>Following the completion of a review of the Community Safety Partnership in terms of its effectiveness, a report of the findings was presented at the meeting on 11 December 08 with a number recommendations for improvement.</p> <p>The annual Strategic Assessment for 2008 is now complete and the draft priorities were considered by the Partnership at its meeting on 11 December 08. This informs the annual refresh of the Community Safety Plan, which is currently being drafted. The refresh will also be used as an opportunity to better align the local priorities with the LAA and develop local targets to facilitate effective performance monitoring.</p> <p>The Partnership received an update of the funding situation from Hampshire County Council for 09/10. The Partnership will be required to offer 15% of their funding allocation to a commissioning pot for two of the LAA priorities which were put on hold. These are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Repeat Incidents of Domestic Violence (NI32) Drug related (Class A offending) rate (NI38) <p>The 15% (£14,707) saving can be made from the Partnerships capital allocation. This will allow the Partnerships revenue allocation to continue to be used to fund key posts within the Community Safety Team which will ensure that we deliver on the priorities within the plan. The Basic Command Unit (BCU) funding (managed by the Police) which the Partnership allocates together with the Area Based Grant (ABG) as one pot has been confirmed for 09/10. This represents 37% of the Partnerships total allocation.</p> <p>The Commissioning Group (a sub group of the County Strategy Group for Crime and Disorder) is conducting a Strategic Review and Information Pack (SRIP) of all of the activity across Hampshire which supports delivery of the aims and objectives of the local and county wide Community Safety Partnerships. This will inform the development of a Commissioning Strategy for 10/11.</p>
