<p>The annual refresh (Year 2) of the Community Safety Plan is now almost complete. The CSP will review the plan in July. A risk assessment document detailing finances for the proposed projects will also be reviewed by the CSP. The refresh has given the CSP the opportunity to better align local priorities with the NI's and LAA targets and develop local targets to facilitate effective performance monitoring.</p> <p>In order to deliver the plan and to monitor performance and evaluation of projects a Performance Group has been established. The Performance Group's remit will be to ensure effective delivery of the Plan and its outcomes. The Performance Group will report direct to the CSP.</p> <p>The Commissioning Group (a sub group of the County Strategy Group for Crime and Disorder) is conducting a Strategic Review and Information Pack (SRIP) of all of the activity across Hampshire which supports delivery of the aims and objectives of the local and county wide Community Safety Partnerships. This will inform the development of a Commissioning Strategy for 10/11. The first phase of consultations for this Commissioning Strategy is to be held in June (dates to be confirmed).</p>
