Progress since June 2009			
<p>The Community Safety Plan (Year 2 refresh) is now complete and was signed off by the partnership in July along with a detailed spending plan in order to deliver the plan. The refresh has given the CSP the opportunity to better align local priorities with the NI's and LAA targets and develop local targets to facilitate effective performance monitoring.</p> <p>A new Performance Group of lead officers has been established to monitor performance of the plan and outcomes. The Performance Group reports directly to the CSP. Delivery of the Community Safety Plan is now a key priority.</p> <p>The Commissioning Group (a sub group of the County Strategy Group for Crime and Disorder) is in the process of a fundamental review across the whole community safety sector, attempting to ensure that all valuable funding is used effectively, achieving the best possible value for money, and is targeted at areas of greatest need. This review will also bring in a joint commissioning and contracting process for all future funding.</p> <p>Eight themed areas of work have been identified which cover both administration and service delivery: Administration: Joint Commissioning Structure. Crime Analysis and Outcome Monitoring. Service Delivery: Domestic Abuse Services, Prolific and Priority Offenders [PPO], a CDRP alcohol Strategy, Drug Interventions Programme [DIP], Anti Social Behaviour (ASB).</p> <p>As part of the consultation for the Strategic Review a consultation questionnaire has been launched and Fareham Community Safety Partnership have encouraged all partners to complete the questionnaire directly online. The Partnership will also submit a collective response. Deadline for submissions is midday on Wednesday 26th August 2009.</p>
