<p>The Partnership has conducted its Strategic Assessment to determine priorities for 08/09 and is currently working on an action plan for this time period. The new priorities have been identified as violent crime, anti-social behaviour, criminal damage and drugs/ alcohol misuse.</p> <p>The Partnership met its target to reduce crime by 15% in 07/08, one of the few Partnerships in the country to do so.</p> <p>A Problem Resolution group has been set up to identify solutions to the relatively high levels of violent crime in the Town Centre, figures for which tend to skew the rest of our statistics.</p>
