Progress since March 2008			
<p>The Partnership has produced its Community Safety Plan for 2008-11, which designates actions to tackle the four identified priority areas of violent crime, anti-social behaviour, criminal damage and drugs/ alcohol misuse.</p> <p>The Partnership exceeded its target to reduce crime by 15% in 07/08, and actually achieved a 17% reduction – which has been commended by GOSE and Hampshire Constabulary.</p> <p>A review of the Partnership is being undertaken to determine how well we are meeting the newly designated National Standards, which will lead to analysis of how we can ensure we are functioning to the best of our abilities.</p>
